Dr. Cynthia Clark is the Founder of Civility Matters™, Professor Emeritus at Boise State University, and an award-winning scholar, author, and educator. She serves as a fellow in the American Academy of Nursing, the NLN Academy of Nursing Education, and co-chaired the American Nurses Association Professional Panel on Incivility, Bullying, and Workplace Violence. Dr. Clark is best known for her groundbreaking work on fostering civility and healthy work and learning environments around the globe.

Dr. Clark has received numerous awards for teaching, service, and research. Her presentations number in the hundreds and her publications have appeared in a broad range of peer-reviewed and open-access venues. Her empirical instruments have been translated into 16 languages and used by scholars in more than 30 countries. Her book, *Creating and Sustaining Civility in Nursing Education*, received 1st place honors as the AJN Book of the Year. Her newly published book, *Core Competencies of Civility for Nursing & Healthcare* is a must-read for all nurses, educators, and healthcare professionals.
